

## Chuditch challenge competition 2020 Terms and Conditions

By entering this competition, you warrant to the Department that you are eligible to enter this competition and agree to these Conditions of Entry.

### Conditions of entry

#### Entry

1. The 'Department' means the Department of Biodiversity, Conservation and Attractions, Parks and Wildlife Service (ABN 38 052 249 024) of 17 Dick Perry Avenue, Kensington, WA, 6151. Subject to any laws governing this competition, any decision of the Department about this competition is final.
2. Entry into the competition is deemed acceptance of these Conditions of Entry. If you do not agree with any part of these Conditions of Entry, you should not enter the competition.
3. You are only eligible to enter this competition if:
  - a. The entrant, is aged 14 years or younger, and has parent or guardian consent to enter;
  - b. The entry is submitted via Facebook or email by the entrant's parent or guardian on their behalf; and
  - c. the entry is the entrant's own original work, and the entrant has not copied or plagiarised another person's work.
4. The competition starts on 1 July 2020 and ends at 5.00 pm (AWST) on 22 July 2020 (the **Promotion Period**). Entries will only be accepted if they are received during the Promotion Period.
5. You can enter this competition via Facebook Direct Message via Parks and Wildlife, Western Australia or Nearer to Nature pages with the name and contact details of the parent/guardian, the name of the entrant/child, a photograph of the entry, and at least one fact the entrant learnt about the chuditch.
6. By submitting an entry to the competition, the entrant consents to and permits the entrant's name, image, image description and learned fact to be reproduced in the following publications and platforms without charge:
  - a. the *LANDSCOPE* magazine and accompanying promotional material, including Electronic Direct Marketing (EDM) campaigns;
  - b. any form of media coverage relating to the Department;
  - c. the Department's websites and online shop; and
  - d. the Department's social media accounts (e.g. on Facebook, Instagram, Twitter);
7. The Department does not accept any responsibility or liability (in negligence or howsoever) for lost, late or incomplete entries, all of which will be ineligible.
8. There is no fee payable to the Department to enter this competition.

9. Employees of DBCA and their immediate family members are ineligible to enter the competition.
10. Entrants agree to their images and names being published on the Department's social media pages, with the possibility of third party sharing, to promote the competition.

## Judging

11. The competition will be judged by the Department's judging panel. The judging panel will consist of employees of the Department's Chuditch Recovery Team. The decision of the judging panel is final.
12. The Department intends that the judging will take place at the end of the Promotion Period.
13. Entries will be judged based on the following criteria (Judging Criteria):
  - a. creativity and aesthetics;
  - b. relevance to the theme of the competition; and
  - c. authenticity.
14. Depending on the number and quality of entries, a People's Choice award may also take place, with a gallery of finalist entries voted by Facebook users. The photo with the most 'likes' would win the People's Choice award.

## Entries

15. Winners will be notified via email or Facebook DM by 5:00 pm AWST 27 July 2020 after the competition ends, and the winning entry/entries will be announced on the Parks and Wildlife Service and Nearer to Nature Facebook pages.

## Prizes

**Winning entry** - *LANDSCOPE* 2021 calendar, selection of WA Naturally Bush Books, two Perth Zoo passes, and a 'Build Your Own' wildlife kit including a chuditch kit supplied by CSIRO.

**People's Choice award** - *LANDSCOPE* 2021 calendar, two Perth Zoo passes and a 'Build Your Own' wildlife kit including a Chuditch kit supplied by CSIRO.

## Privacy

16. The Department requires entrants to provide certain information, including personal information, in the entry form. The Department requires the information for the following purposes:

- a. to enable the Department to identify and contact the relevant entrant for any reason related to this competition, for example, to notify successful entrants.
  - b. for the general administration and conduct of the competition.
17. When you submit an entry, the Department will record and use the parent/guardian's personal information (including email address) and the name of the entrant for the purposes of including in the competition and, where appropriate, selecting winning entries. By submitting an entry form, you consent to:
  1. verifying your eligibility to enter the competition;
  2. communicating with you (e.g. to seek further information about the entry);
  3. advising you of the outcome of the competition;
  4. obtaining feedback about the competition for evaluation purposes; and
  5. exercising the Department 's rights under these Conditions of Entry (including the right to publish the names of winners).
  6. Your entry being shared on DBCA social media accounts and by third party social media accounts such as CSIRO and Perth Zoo.
18. If you do not provide the personal information required by the entry form, your entry may be deemed ineligible.
19. All records will be managed and disposed of in accordance with the State Records Act 2000 (WA).

### **Modification or cancellation**

20. The Department may exercise its discretion, at any time:
  - a. to modify, suspend, postpone or cancel this competition without notice to entrants; and
  - b. change or amend these Conditions of Entry without notice to entrants.
