

State Forest Amendment

Upgrades to South Western Highway

5 January 2020

Conservation and Land Management Act 1984 **Section 9**

In accordance with section 9(4) of the *Conservation and Land Management Act 1984* (CALM Act) the Minister advises of his intention to act under section 9(3)(b) of the CALM Act.

At the request of Main Roads Western Australia (Main Roads), the Minister for Environment proposes to excise 0.06 hectares from State Forest No. 38.

Main Roads is seeking the excision to facilitate upgrades to a 93-kilometre section of South Western Highway between Vasse Highway and Deep River Bridge, near Walpole. The upgrades include seal widening and improved curve geometry. Main Roads advises that the upgrades will result in significant improvements to road user safety.

As part of these upgrades, portions of Sir James Mitchell National Park, Dordagup National Park and Shannon National Park are also proposed for excision. The excision from the national parks are being managed by the Department of Planning, Lands and Heritage.
