

State Forest Amendment

Rationalisation of Wells Terminal Substation

Conservation and Land Management Act 1984 **Section 9**

In accordance with section 9(4) of the *Conservation and Land Management Act 1984* (CALM Act) the Minister advises of his intention to act under section 9(3)(b) of the CALM Act.

At the request of Western Power, the Minister for Environment proposes to amend State Forest No. 14 to rationalise the tenure of the Wells Terminal Substation, located 17 kilometres north-west of Boddington.

The Wells Terminal Substation was constructed in 2008 along existing Western Power infrastructure in State Forest No. 14 to meet increasing demands associated with the Boddington Gold Mine. Western Power is seeking to rationalise the tenure of the Wells Terminal Substation. The excision will not involve native vegetation clearing and are administrative actions only.

To rationalise the tenure of Wells Terminal Substation the Minister for Environment proposes to excise 4.6484 hectares from State Forest No. 14 to support the creation of a new Crown reserve for management by Western Power.
