

State Forest Amendment

Upgrades to Bradbury Road

4 November 2022

Conservation and Land Management Act 1984 **Section 9**

In accordance with section 9(4) of the *Conservation and Land Management Act 1984* (CALM Act) the Minister advises of his intention to act under section 9(3)(b) of the CALM Act.

At the request of the Shire of Collie, the Minister for Environment proposes to amend State Forest No. 4 to facilitate the extension of the Bradbury Road road reserve over an existing portion of Bradbury Road within State Forest 4.

While the majority of Bradbury Road is found within road reserve, the final 800m of road has been constructed within State Forest 4, providing informal access to a number of freehold lots adjoining the State forest. The owners of Lot 1482 are seeking to legalise access to their property via Bradbury Road, simultaneously formalising access to Lots 1478, 1480 and 1481.

No road upgrades or impacts to native vegetation are proposed as part of this tenure rationalisation.

To dedicate this additional portion of Bradbury Road, the Minister for Environment proposes to excise 1.6188 hectares from State Forest No. 4 to support the creation of a new Road reserve for management by the Shire of Collie.
