# IMPORT – Herpetofauna

Wildlife Conservation (Reptiles and Amphibians) Regulations 2002 (IH)

## ATTACHMENT TO HERPETOFAUNA IMPORT APPLICATION

As per Section 14 of the *Wildlife Conservation (Reptiles and Amphibians) Regulations 2002* fees apply to the import and export of pet herpetofauna in Western Australia.

A licensee authorised to import pet herpetofauna must, when lodging a report under regulation 12(1)(b) of the *Wildlife Conservation (Reptiles and Amphibians) Regulations 2002*, for each animal imported under the licence must pay a **fee** of:-

**\$10** for each category 2 animal

**\$25** for each category 3 animal

**\$50** for each category 4 animal

**\$100** for each category 5 animal

Following the arrival of the herpetofauna into Western Australia, the licensed importer must 'lodge a report' together with the prescribed fee payment to the Department of Parks and Wildlife, Wildlife Licensing Section. This must be done as soon as possible after the licensee has possession of the animals as detailed on the import licence.

'Report lodgement' should detail exactly how many of each species arrived to Western Australia, their date of arrival and confirmation of sender details and dispatch. The fee payment as above must accompany this report.

The \$30.00 per consignment fee on the import application page (to be paid at the time of application for an import licence) is separate to the fee on this page
