



NOTICE OF FEE CHANGES

New fees for licences under the *Wildlife Conservation Act 1950*

The Wildlife Conservation Amendment Regulations 2017 were published in the Western Australian *Government Gazette* on 11 August 2017 to amend or introduce some wildlife licence fees. Each year, government departments are required to review tariffs, fees and charges with the aim of recovering costs for services offered.

The table below outlines the licence fees, as prescribed in the Wildlife Conservation Regulations 1970, that have recently changed. These fees come into effect on **1 January 2018**.

Licence type	New fee
Regulation 12 Licence to breed and keep avian fauna - Advanced avicultural licence	\$30
Regulation 15 Licence to take fauna for educational or public purposes (other than fauna interaction licences - \$75 fee applies)	\$100
Regulation 16 Licence to keep fauna for educational or public purposes - One class of fauna - Two or more classes of fauna	\$100 \$200
