PART A CEO requirements and specifications relating to Part A of this STF.

The supplier must:

1. Complete and sign Part A on at least 2 copies of this STF when transporting specifically controlled sandalwood.
2. Provide a copy of this form with Part A completed to the CEO via Wildlife Protection Branch (email:wildlife.protection@dbca.wa.gov.au; fax: 08 9219 8242), a minimum of 72 hours prior to transportation, or in the case of plantation(cultivated) sandalwood, up to 30 days but with a minimum of 24 hours prior to transportation.
3. Retain a copy of the STF with Part A completed for 5 years as a record and provide 2 copies to the Driver (Part B).

CEO requirements and specifications relating to Part B of this STF

The Driver of the vehicle transporting this specifically controlled sandalwood must:

1. Complete and sign Part B on at least 2 copies of this STF before starting their journey.
2. While transporting specifically controlled sandalwood be in possession of at least 2 hard copies of this STF or possess, at the relevant time, the approved sandalwood tracking form in an electronic format.
3. On delivery of the consignment, the driver hands the 2 copies of the STF form to the recipient of the specifically controlled sandalwood. (Part C)

The person receiving the specifically controlled sandalwood must:

1. Complete Part C of at least 2 copies of this STF.
2. Provide a copy of this STF, with at least Parts A, B and C fully completed and signed, to the CEO via the Wildlife Protection Branch (email: wildlife.protection@dbca.wa.gov.au; fax: 08 9219 8242) within 72 hours of having received the specifically controlled sandalwood.
3. Retain a completed STF for 5 years as a record.

Additional information:

1. Specifically controlled sandalwood means sandalwood with a diameter greater than 25mm at the smallest end when stripped of bark, or the roots of sandalwood. (r 3 of the Biodiversity Conservation Regulations 2018)
2. STF for each supplier must be numbered sequentially using the format "Supplier licence number/STF tracking form number" e.g. L000123/STF2.
3. If an approved electronic STF is used, reference in this STF to hard copies, includes a reference to a completed and signed electronic copy.
4. It is an offence to:
 - a. Include information in the STF which you know to be false or misleading.
 - b. Alter any information or statement in this STF, other than to correct a mistake, and if a mistake is correct, it must be corrected as soon as possible and such that the altered entry is legible or recoverable and the person correcting the mistake records their identity.
 - c. Fail to complete all information required.
 - d. Fail to comply with the CEO's requirements specified in this STF.
(Biodiversity Conservation Regulations 2018, r 136. Penalty \$25,000.00: modified penalty \$1250.00, (individual), \$6250.00 (body corporate))

A Wildlife Officer or authorised person may undertake an inspection of the *specifically controlled sandalwood* being transported under s198 and for that purpose may stop and enter vehicles under s201 of the *Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016*.
